**The History**

Château La Croix Saint-Estèphe is the second wine of Château Le Crock (which became Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel in 2020 with the 2018 vintage). Built in Saint-Estèphe by the Merman family at the beginning of the 19th century, the Château le Crock is surrounded by vineyards and a 6 hectares park. Originally called «Cru de Crock», the estate had only 17 hectares of vines.



**The Vineyard**

The name was changed in 1880, as the vineyard continues to expand. In 1903, with the acquisition by the Cuvelier family, the Château reached 32 hectares and developed a second wine : La Croix S<sup>t</sup>-Estèphe.



**The grape**

56% Merlot, 40% CabS Sauvignon, 4% Cab Franc



**Tasting note**

Deep cherry red color. Very expressive since the opening, the wine reveals pure aromas of black and red fruits. Nicely structured, fresh and lively, it can be enjoyed now paired with food and will even be better in a year or two. Representative of the Saint-Estèphe wines, it is beautifully balanced and fruity which make it pleasant in its young years.
