The History

The Grape

60% Roussanne, 30% Marsanne, 10% Viognier

Wine Making

After harvest, the grapes are gently pressed then barrel fermented separately using native yeast. Maturation in neutral oak barrels takes as long as 16 months to insure a rich wine, with flavors of white peach and honey before precise blending.



Tasting Note

A wonderful white Rhone style blend of Marsanne, Roussanne and Viognier from the Los Olivos District of Santa Barbara County. Farmed in the amazing climate of the Santa Ynez Valley these three wonderful grape varieties make a rich and dense blended white wine.
